<u>The Consecration (Seal) Prayer</u> <u>to God the Father</u>

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Heavenly Father, source of Life, Love and Eternal Happiness. You have bestowed upon us the precious gift of life itself. We beg You, Heavenly Father, never allow us to take this gift for granted. What is more You have called us to holiness. You have called us to participate in Your Divine Family life through, with and in Jesus Christ. We ask that you grant us, in Your Beneficence, all of the graces necessary to live in accord with Your Divine Will and to offer You, at each and every moment, the fullness of our gratitude, our worship, our thanksgiving and our supplication. We formally consecrate ourselves to You, as predigal children returning to the Father Who loves us. Accept us, put a royal diadem on our finger. Cloak us in royal purple and prepare us for the feast, the banquet, that You have prepared for all Your faithful children. Amen

Anyone saying the above Consecration Prayer with sincere heart, which God our Father Himself dictated, will receive the <u>Seal of the Father</u> for their soul. This leads one's soul to become immune to the attacks of Satan during <u>the Chastisement</u>, through additional graces the Father promised to pour out onto those souls who bear His Seal. The Seal of the Father both supercedes and annuls the mark, name and number of the beast (Revelations 13). Please visit the <u>Seal of God the Father page</u> for further details.

The Consecration (Seal) Prayer to the Father should be said **in a state of sanctifying grace.** If one desires to obtain the Father's Seal but is aware of not being in a state of grace, the Sacrament of Reconciliation (Confession) should first be attended. Otherwise, the Sacrament should be sincerely received as early possible. Renewal of the Seal occurs not solely through reciting the Consecration Prayer, but through attending daily Mass and receiving the Eucharist in a state of grace.

Benedict XVI on Consecration to God the Father (1/25/12, General audience, Vatican City).

During today's *General audience*, Benedict XVI invited everyone to meditate upon the priestly prayer of Jesus Christ to the Father, and to pray to God themselves asking Him, "to help us enter fully into the plan He has for each of us. Let us ask Him to consecrate us to Himself, that we may belong to Him and show increasing love for others, both near and far. Let us ask Him to help us open our prayers to the world, not limiting them to requests for help in our own problems, but remembering our fellow man before the Lord and learning the beauty of interceding for others. Let us ask Him for the gift of visible unity among all those who believe in Christ ... that we may be ready to respond to anyone who asks us about the reasons for our hope."

Bead 1—Hail Mary full of grace, the Lord is with Thee. Blessed art Thou among women and blessed is the Fruit of Thy Womb Jesus. Holy Mary, Mother of God, pray for us sinners now and at the hour of our death. Amen.

Bead 2—Jesus, my God and my Savior, You loved me so much, You died for me on the Cross, so that I, too, could return to our Father in Heaven. You are the Way, the Truth, and the Life. Through Your

Holy Eucharist, please sustain me and be present with me always on my journey home. Amen.

Bead 3—Holy Spirit, my God and my Sanctifier, Jesus sent You to me for my journey back home to the Father. Please purify and refine me. Fill me with Your Divine Light and Love so that the Presence of

Our Father who art in Heaven, hallowed be Thy name; Thy Kingdom come, Thy will be done on earth as it is in Heaven. Give us this day our daily bread; and forgive us our trespasses as we forgive those who trespass against us; and lead us not into temptation but deliver us from evil. Amen.
